Greetings In the Name of our Lord,

One thing I am convinced of is the more people lose faith in mankind, the better it is for the gospel! There are some noteworthy events I want to draw your attention to

and get on your calendar.

On September 14<sup>th</sup> and the 21<sup>st</sup> we will partner with our State Convention and host two Evangelism Conferences. The 14<sup>th</sup> will be in Menifee, the 21<sup>st</sup> in Ontario. Like last year, there is a \$1,000 grant for each church that participates and hosts a follow up event. Along these lines, the State Convention will be October 21-22 at Magnolia Church in Riverside. In conjunction with the State Convention, our churches are encouraged to participate in Crossover. Crossover is an opportunity for California Southern Baptists to impact the communities surrounding the CSBC annual meeting. This would be any evangelist event held during the month of October in our Association. As with the Evangelism Conferences, there are grants made available to participating churches that can range from \$500-\$2,000 dollars. Between the conferences and Crossover, there is a lot of potential assistance to churches who participate. I wanted to bring this to your attention so that you can get this on your radar and calendar! More information will follow.

I am also very excited to announce the rebirth of our Pastors Retreat Sept 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> in Forest Home, located north of Yucaipa. This is an excellent campground and we have reserved the premium cabins. I recently heard pastor Andy Addis speak on the need for healthy rhythms and patterns in a pastor's or staff members life when it came to ministry, family and over all spiritual, mental, and physical health. It was something I wish I had been exposed to years ago. Very practical, thought provoking and relevant. Please calendar this and join us. Again, more information will follow.

These listening sessions will have a definite impact as to the direction, staffing needs, and priorities of our State Convention.

Wisdom's Unexpected Penalty: Proverbs 5:8

**Proverbs 5:8.** Keep to a path far from her, do not go near the door of her house. INTRODUCTION

Proverbs 5 addresses specifically the sin of adultery. However, in a broader sense, it speaks to the battle between living the righteous life God has planned for us and the unrighteous life based on the norms of society. Adultery, in this case, would refer to the temptations of the world. Abstinence represents the path of obedience to the Spirit.

God calls us to purity. 1 Thessalonians 4:7 teaches: *For God did not call us to be impure but to live a holy life*. Sexual immorality represents only one act of disobedience to God. He rescued His children from unrighteousness. Now God expects them to be spiritual. All acts of disobedience are anathema to Him.
