God's Truth

Jesus therefore was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" John 8:31-32. One must keep on pointing out that Christianity is a statement which, if false, is of no importance, and if true, of infinite importance. The one thing it cannot be is moderately important." – C. S. Lewis *Introduction: God is absolute Truth.*

God's truth and His righteousness are absolutes. Mankind's attempt to rationalize God's truth is in vain. Truth is relative to God. Moral truth relies on the authority of God as outlined in His Word, the Bible. Mankind rationalizes man's

laws. We try to do the same with God's truth. However, unlike the police, God is always there. *Because God is absolute truth...*

1. <u>I will believe what He says and live accordingly</u>. You are truly My disciples if you keep obeying My teachings. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:31-32 NLT). We all desire freedom. However, true freedom, the freedom taught in the Bible, requires that we be obedient to God. If we are to experience the freedom Jesus is promising His disciples, we must obey His teachings. The foundation for Christ's teachings are found in the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:36-40), love God and love others, and the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20), spread the gospel message, baptize those who accept it, and disciple those who believe by teaching them His truth, the Bible.

2. <u>He follows through on His promises</u>. *Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him* (John 3:36). God has given us a myriad of promises in His Word. However, none is so precious or <u>so terrifying as the one found in John 3:36</u>. To those who believe in Him (Romans 10:9-10) and have made Jesus the Lord of their lives, He promises eternal life. This promise is the precious part. But to those who reject Jesus, the promise is the full wrath of God, eternal wrath. This means unrelenting eternal punishment.

3. <u>His Word is True and Completely Righteous</u>. The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. The decrees of the LORD are firm, and all of them are righteous (Psalm 19:8-9b, NASB). In Psalm 19: 8-9b we see three interesting benefits of the words of God. First, we see that since God's Word is right (righteous), He will give us a rejoicing heart. Secondly, God's message is pure (without any spot). Finally, we see that God's Word is firm (not wavering). The Word of God will cause us to be upright and stable in our ways (Psalm 119:11).

<u>4. God's Truth is Everlasting</u>. *His merciful kindness is great toward us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever. Praise the Lord* (Psalm 117:2)! <u>God's truth endures forever because He has no beginning or end and He is eternal and immutable</u>.
