



UNCONDITIONAL PROMISES

God cannot deny Himself (2Timothy 2:13), He always stays faithful to His promises. God does not change (Malachi 3:6), He is immutable. His Word never changes (Proverbs 30:5). God's unconditional promises are always fulfilled.

1. One Way to Jesus: John 14:6 expresses an interesting unconditional promise. It explains: "Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." It would seem that there is a condition. To get to the Father you must come through Jesus. However, the verse is guaranteeing that there is only one way to God. The condition only applies if we reject Jesus by believing that there can be multiple ways to reach God. Jesus is promising us that He is the only way to salvation. All mankind can reach God through Him.

- 2. One Hope in Jesus: Romans 8:38-39 makes this clear. Paul, under the influence of the Spirit of God, writes: "For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Now, that's unconditional love. There is no restriction on the promise of God's love for us.
- 3. One Life in Jesus: Philippians 4:19 explains: "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus." In this unconditional statement, God promises to meet our needs. He does not promise to fulfill all of our wants. The old saying, "Be careful what you pray for" is so true in this instance. We may desire a Tesla and pray for it. But when God sends us a good and dependable Ford, we had better fall to our knees and be thankful. God makes no mistakes in His promises to us.
