BE WISE - Introduction

It may have been inserted into the Bible as a book by man, but the Spirit has assembled Proverbs into a collection of chapters guiding us through valuable lessons about God's wisdom. Proverbs 1 establishes the purpose of the entire treatise, wisdom. This overriding theme of the Book of Proverbs, as inspired by the Spirit, addresses the needs of humanity in our present life.

To be wise suggests knowledge, understanding, and possession of the ability to apply it for positive outcomes. In addition, wise people share their wisdom with others. The Book of Proverbs is a tutorial not only for those seeking wisdom but also for those who wish to be its teacher.

The opposite of wisdom is foolishness. The Book of Proverbs describes those who do not desire or seek wisdom as fools. They stumble through life making poor decisions impacting their own lives and the lives and livelihood of those around them.

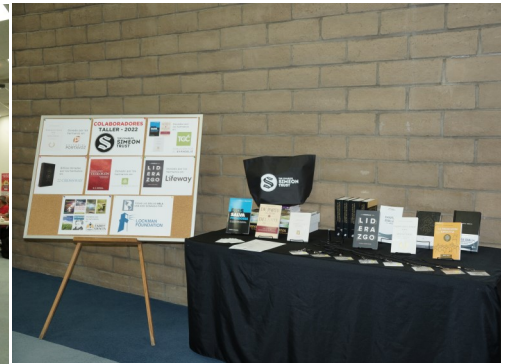
Fools have no moral compass. Psalm 53:1 says in part: The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, and their ways are vile; there is no one who does good. Without the direction of the Spirit of God, humans continually make unwise decisions. While the wise have their guidance from God, fools rely on themselves for leadership.

The focus of this great volume relates to living in spiritual connection with others. The God-human interface has its foundation in God's wisdom. The wise resolve and direct their actions and the actions of others for mutual benefit. The fool is self-centered and cares more about themselves than others.

Wisdom is a gift from God. We are not born wise. Solomon was a young man when he became the king of Israel. He had much to learn. He prayed to God asking for a discerning heart. God answered his prayer (Read 1 Kings 3:10-14).

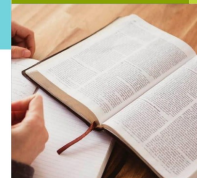
