BE WISE (Proverbs)
Proverbs 1:1: Solomon

Many ancients, as well as contemporary scholars, consider Solomon to be the author of Proverbs. Due to his obedience to God, the king was well equipped for the assignment fostered by the Holy Spirit.

The author of 1 Kings describes Solomon's wisdom in 4:29-32: *God gave Solomon wisdom and very great insight, and a breadth of understanding as measureless as the sand on the seashore. Solomon's wisdom was greater than the wisdom of all the men of the East and greater than all the wisdom of Egypt. He was wiser than any other man, including Ethan the Ezrahite — wiser than Heman, Calcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol. And his fame spread to all the surrounding nations. He spoke three thousand proverbs and his songs numbered a thousand and five.*

To suggest the text of Proverbs came from another source, other than King Solomon, would be to deny the inspiration and inerrancy of these documents as scripture. If the Bible, in its original form, is God-breathed, as 2 Timothy 3:16 purports, then Solomon was directed by the Spirit of God to write them.

We might assume the king's writings were compiled as a completed discourse. Instead, each proverb appears to be a standalone text. Solomon's sayings would have been recorded on scrolls and kept for posterity. At some point, under the direction of the Spirit, the king compiled his writings into a textbook. They are designed to train his children and others who sought after wisdom.

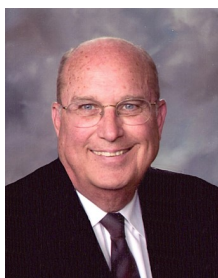
