Exodus 33:15 (NASB), Then he said to Him, "If Your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here.

"Good news or bad news first?" How do you usually answer this question? Like most, I usually prefer the bad news first. Lets end on a good note in hopes that whatever we end with trumps the former. In Exodus 33 God gave a similar scenario to Moses. Bad news is that God's presence wouldn't accompany Moses and the people of Israel into the Promised Land. Good news is that He will be sending his angel instead!

I know, I know...Moses didn't buy it either. Moses' response to the Lord was basically "We're not going, if You're not going". An angel was not going to cut it for him. As children of the Living God we should have the same mentality and conviction. Where are the areas that the Lord is leading us into? Are we certain that His presence is there to meet us? Let us not take a single step in any direction without Him stepping ahead of us first. The decisions and the choices we make should be because God is on the move and that we desire to be near and in His presence. I would rather be in the desert, and yet in His presence than in the Promised Land without. We may ask ourselves, how would we know whether or not His presence will be going ahead of us? The answer is in Scripture, constant communication with the Lord. Moses went back and forth over the topic, and when Moses realized what God's intentions were he held his ground on not moving without God. Praying that we do the same.
