Acts 2:44-45 (NASB) And all the believers were together and had all things in common; and they would sell their property and possessions and share them with all, to the extent that anyone had need.

You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ (Romans 8:9).

He Responds: *That's OK God, I found a space myself.*" Thirdly, the Spirit uses others to work the miracle. Many years ago, I was having lower stomach pain. The doctor said I needed a colonoscopy, OUCH. They found a benign tumor and said I was not to worry about it. I did! I worried. Over the next few years, I repeated the colonoscopy making sure it was not growing. We began praying about the tumor. After the fifth colonoscopy, the doctor reported the submucosal tumor had disappeared. I praised God for the miracle he had worked in my life. The Spirit works in us, for us, and through us.
