But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

Most of us are familiar with the famous secular Christmas Carol line "He's making a list, checking it twice...". When we were kids the image of Santa Clause came to mind and we know that he has a *nice list* and a *naughty list*. A merit based theology where those who made it to the former list enjoyed the joy of receiving gifts for Christmas and those on the later, lump of coals. As a kid that was an incentive for us to behave, listen, and do good. However, if that were true we all deserve the lump of coals in our stocking.

Scripture denounces this doctrine with passages like the one we read above, grace is the only prerequisite needed for salvation and all good that proceeds from God. Ephesians 2:8-9 says "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast." 
