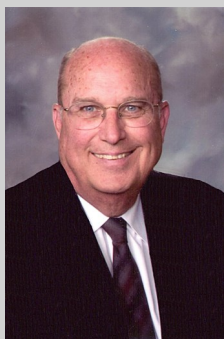
## **JONATHAN DE LA O**

#### **JESUS IS LORD**

# HOLY MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH

*Holy Missionary Baptist Church is a small, inviting congregation in Pomona, which will be celebrating their 56<sup>th</sup> year anniversary this year!* Pastor Lacey was called to lead as senior pastor on October 25, 2020. This church has found unique ways to reach out to their community and to show those around them the deep love of Christ.

Pastor Lacey grew up as the fourth of eight children and was not involved in church or following God. During his years in college, Pastor Lacey responded to God's call to live for Him and his life took a new direction. He started attending a local church with a deep hunger to know God, and soon started at Cross-roads Bible College, earning his bachelor's degree. As an adult and father of three sons, he continued his theological training at Liberty University, completing a master's degree in Christian ministry in 2015 at age 50.

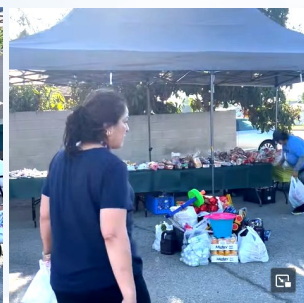


During those years he attended John MacArthur's Shepherds Conference in Southern California, and met his wife, Lori. They married in May 2017 and moved to Southern California. Together, Lori and Pastor Lacey served faithfully at Mt. Zion Church of Ontario. In 2018, during a revival service, Pastor Lacey sensed a clear call from the Holy Spirit to shepherd God's people and was led to serve as Assistant Pastor at Ontario Ranch Church in Ontario, California.

God soon led Lacey and Lori to attend the NAMB Assessment Retreat and from the moment they arrived, they felt a deep sense of belonging. Although the church planting assessment process is known to be intense and nerve-racking, they *experienced it as a sacred time of reflection an opportunity to share how God had led them in their walk with Him.* By the end of the retreat, they were humbled and grateful to be approved as NAMB church planters. Around that same time, Holy Missionary Baptist Church of Pomona had entered a pastoral search season following the passing of their pastor. Pastor Lacey was invited to serve one Sunday, teaching Bible Study, leading worship, and preaching the Gospel. After prayer and submission to the leading of the Holy Spirit, Pastor Lacey submitted an application in which he was called as pastor in 2020.

*The Holy Spirit stirred in Pastor Lacey and Lori a deep compassion for this flock that was without a shepherd* (Matthew 9:36). Their church motto is, "In Loving God, We Are Here to Serve You," the disciples of HMBC remain steadfast in fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). Their mission is to evangelize the lost, disciple one another, and maintain a strong, visible presence within the Pomona community. HMBC serves their community by offering housing support, clothing, and food resources. Every third Saturday of the month, Holy Missionary Baptist Church hosts a food and clothing giveaway, which also comes with a warm meal. They recently started a community Garden where local families can come to help garden. You can keep Holy Missionary Baptist Church in prayer as they remain committed to Christ and grow in knowledge, wisdom and understanding. ## TESTIMONY - CALL TO MINISTRY - DERYL LACKEY



I was recently asked to share about my call to the ministry. First A brief testimony - I was fifteen when I acknowledged Christ as my Lord and Savior on March 1st, 1976, at my home in Bakersfield, California. Pastor Bill Whala is the individual who was there when it all came together in my heart. I was baptized the following Sunday March 7th, at the Landmark Missionary Baptist Church located in Bakersfield. It was in August of 1978 I was at a youth camp in northern California when I knew something was happening in my heart, but I just wasn't clear as to what it was. I recall during the invitation the pastor asked if there was anyone who was feeling called to the ministry. Since he invited those who felt that calling to go up front, I went out the back door and found myself sitting on a log in the trees. A wonderful pastor, whose face I can still see, but whose name I've never known, came up to me and asked how he could help. After a series of questions, he asked, do you think God is calling you to life committed foremost to the ministry. I told him I did not know. He simply said, "well pray and ask Him!" So, I did, and when I finished a very short prayer, I looked at him and said I really don't know. Instead of pressuring me, talking me into it, or trying to rush me up front for the sake of numbers or show, he graciously said the following. "I would imagine there is a part of you that is afraid God is going to say no and a part of you is afraid that He is going to say yes. Just tell him you are willing if He will make it clear, if the calling is of God it won't go away anytime soon." Wonderful words, just what I needed. By November God had made it quite clear, and on November 19th of that year, during the altar call I got close to going to the alter at our church. Instead of getting all the way to the altar I turned to the left and went out a side door and found myself on a small step. (Thanks to Google, I have a picture of that step in my office). It was there that I "surrendered my life to the ministry" as we called it. I remember at that time there were two strong passions in my heart. Number one was that those who did not know Christ would know him, and number two that those who did know Christ would truly experience God in their life, not merely go through the motions of being a Christian. Those two passions are still the ones that I find the most fulfillment in today.

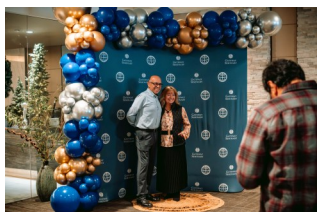
